The City of Wyoming Police Department would like to remind you that yellow painted curbs designate areas that are strictly prohibited from parking, stopping or standing.

These areas have been identified as locations that need to remain open in order to significantly enhance the ability of drivers to properly see the school children as they utilize the crosswalk areas to and from school.

Parking in these areas, even for only a quick second, can jeopardize the ability of a driver to adequately see the children. It is for that reason the curbs are painted yellow in those areas and parking, stopping or standing is strictly prohibited. These highly visible yellow curbs allow parents that are dropping off or picking up children a quick reminder of where not to park, stop or stand.

Complying with these parking restrictions not only avoids a ticket; it helps keep our precious children safe!

Please assist our efforts by doing your part in helping keep the community safe by not parking, stopping or standing in these areas for any reason.
